
A special thank you to the Myles PTA for all they have done this year. Their dedication to volunteerism and support of our school is greatly appreciated. We are all grateful!

Nurse's Notes:

How can I protect My Child From the Sun's UV Rays?

- Avoid the sun's rays between 10:00 a.m. & 4:00 p.m.
- Choose a sunscreen with a "broad spectrum" on the label.
- Zinc oxide is good for the nose, cheeks, tops of ears and more.
- Use sun protection factor or at least 15 SPF.
- Rub sunscreen in well and apply 30 minutes before going outside.
- Use a sunscreen on a cloudy days too!

Medications:

We are experiencing students bringing **"Over the Counter" medications to school. No Medications are allowed to be transported by a student.**

When the medication is discovered it is locked in the Health Office medicine cabinet and a parent or designated adult must come in to pick it up. It will not be sent back home with the child.
