Notes from the Nurse

We are halfway through the school year! We are seeing a lot of illness, especially strep throat. If your child is complaining of a sore throat for 2 or more days and sometimes with a headache or stomachaches, please consider following-up. Some children are presenting with a fever while others are not. Please keep your child home if an illness is suspected and for a **full 24 hours following treatment.**

We ask that you encourage no sharing of food/drinks, frequent hand washing and proper covering of coughs/sneezes (elbow).

We have seen a few flu cases so far. If your child tests positive, please keep your child home per recommendation of the physician and notify the school. **This is generally 3-5 days and at least 24 hours after fever has subsided.**

With the indecisive weather out there, there is all the more reason to make sure your child has a **COMPLETE spare outfit** in their locker should they need to change. If an article of clothing is borrowed from the health office, please be kind enough to wash and return.

The next Kindergarten registration date is **March 21st.** Please turn in up-to-date physicals and vaccination records with the school paperwork. If the child hasn't had their well visit yet, please bring it following the appointment. Thank you!
