WHAT'S HAPPENING IN THE COUNSELING OFFICE?

During the week of September 17th, the Counselors will be presenting our “Ready , Set, Apply” presentations for 2 and 4 year colleges in the Library Computer labs which will cover all the information needed for students to get going on college applications. **You must sign up for a “Ready, Set, Apply” workshop in Naviance during ADP or a study hall. This is mandatory for all seniors.**

Take a good look at your schedule, as the courses you have selected will be the ones that will be submitted to colleges as your senior year program. Colleges will be aware of changes that you make once you submit applications and may ask you to explain any change in your senior year program

Senior Reviews: During the weeks of September 24th and October 1st, seniors will have an opportunity for a short individual appointment with their counselor to discuss their post-secondary plans. These individual appointments will be scheduled during study hall time as much as possible. Further information will be forthcoming

Have you been thinking about your plans for life after high school? If you are planning on applying directly to a 4 year college, it is important that you take either the SAT or ACT. If you have not taken one of these yet, you should plan on doing so in October. Many students retake the SAT in the fall of their senior year to try and improve their scores. You may register at www.collegeboard.com for the SATs and www.actstudent.org for the ACTs.

Worth Considering!

Throughout the fall many college representatives will be visiting our school. If you are interested in speaking with a college representative you need to sign up through Naviance. You will then need to go to the Counseling Office to get a pass. Report to your class during the time the visit is scheduled and show your pass to your teacher. After your visit is over you will return to your scheduled class. In order to see the representative you **MUST SIGN UP!** **The schedule of college representatives will be posted on the Counseling Department calendar on our web page as well as Naviance. Check it often!**
